Guide for Participation and Publication in the International Conference:

**“Shared Human Ethics and Its Role in Building a World Governed by Justice, Peace,
and International Compassion”**

12 September 2026 – London

I. Conditions for Participation with a Conference Paper

The conference welcomes the participation of researchers, academics, experts, and those interested in the fields of human values and civilizational dialogue related to the conference theme, through the submission of a paper that meets the following criteria:

1. The paper must be relevant to the conference theme or one of its approved thematic strands;
2. The paper must be characterized by originality and scholarly rigor, and must offer a knowledge contribution or analytical perspective that advances the scholarly discussion on the conference theme;
3. The participant must submit a scientific abstract of between 300 and 500 words, including: the title of the paper; the problem statement; the main objectives; the key ideas or expected findings; and five keywords;
4. Papers are accepted in any of the following languages: Arabic, English, French, or Spanish;
5. Abstracts will be evaluated by the conference’s scientific committee;
6. Each presentation will be allotted between 15 and 20 minutes, followed by a scholarly discussion with the audience;
7. Participants wishing to present using visual slides (PowerPoint) must send their presentation before the end of August 2026;
8. The conference will be held in two formats: in-person participation in the city of London, and remote participation via the conference’s electronic platform.

II. Participation in the Peer-Reviewed Collective Volume

As part of valorizing the scholarly contributions presented during the conference, the International Center for Human Values and Civilizational Cooperation intends to publish a peer-reviewed collective volume comprising a select group of studies and research papers drawn from the conference proceedings. We therefore invite you to submit your research papers in accordance with the following conditions:

1. The paper must be original and not previously published or accepted for publication elsewhere;
2. The paper must be derived from the presentation given at the conference or from the conference theme and its thematic strands;
3. The paper must comply with the scientific and methodological standards recognized in academic publishing;
4. The paper must be between 3,000 and 5,000 words in length, including footnotes and references;
5. The paper must be accompanied by two abstracts: one in Arabic (approximately 150 words) and one in English (approximately 150 words);
6. The researcher must include five keywords in both Arabic and English;





7. Arabic-language articles must be typed in Arabic Traditional font, size 16 for the body text and size 14 for footnotes; for foreign languages, Times New Roman, size 12;
8. All papers and studies will be subject to peer review by a scientific committee;
9. Sources and references must be documented in the following format:
 - **Books:** Author's name (first name then family name or known name), translator or editor if applicable, title of the book, publisher, country, edition, year, volume and page number;
 - **Periodicals:** Author's name (first name then family name or known name), title of the article in quotation marks, name of the journal, volume and/or issue number, year of publication, city or country, volume and page number.

III. Important Dates

Deadline for submission of abstracts: 20 July 2026;

Date of the committee's response to participants: 30 July 2026;

Deadline for receipt of presentation slides: 1 September 2026;

Deadline for submission of full papers for the collective volume: 1 September 2026;

Conference dates: 12 September 2026.

IV. Organizational Information

1. All participants will receive a certificate of participation accredited by the Center;
2. Researchers whose papers are accepted for publication will receive a certificate of publication following the release of the collective volume;
3. Given the Center's non-profit nature, participants attending in person in London will bear their own travel, accommodation, and personal transportation costs;
4. The organizing committee will, whenever possible, provide participants with information on suitable accommodation options and preferential rates with the conference's partner establishments.
